

TROOP 843 FUNDRAISERS

Fundraisers are used to earn money for the troop. This money is used to cover troop expenses such as new camping equipment, maintaining existing troop equipment, Council event costs, and other miscellaneous expenses related with running the troop.

A portion of this money is set aside to fund the “Individual Boy Account” (*money that may be used by each individual scout to help fund personal scout equipment or events fees*). This percent may vary depending on the financial status of the troop. The troop committee will determine the percentage of the profit that will fund the “Boy Account” on an event basis. (*exp. 50% troop – 50% scout or 75% troop – 25% scout*)

Determining how much each scout will receive depends on each scout’s participation in each fundraising event. The scout **MUST** participate in the fundraiser to earn any portion of the profits for his account.

For example, if the percentage is 50/50:

- and a scout sells \$500.00 in wreaths, 50 percent of the profit earned on that \$500.00 will go towards that boys account.
- and we had a brat fry, 50% of the profit will be split equally among the boys that helped with the event.
